Law St); more parking enforcement; sign changes; implement no garbage collection during the hour 8-9am.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parent volunteers sometimes does not work • Try to communicate that people not park in front of driveways, bus areas, turning in against traffic <p>All present had a thorough discussion on this serious safety concern on drop off/ pick up times. These are some suggestions that were mentioned:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Handing out tickets especially to repeat offenders • Make signs more visible, no Right hand turn during the stated hours of 8-9am and 2-4pm – write or send an email citing ‘Safety concern’ to Councillor Doucette at Councillor_Doucette@Toronto.ca <p>Unanimous decision of those present to implement these Stages:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Give a warning 2. After first warning and repeats = \$110 fine plus 3 demerit points <p>* Get parking enforcement to hand tickets to anyone who parks in the school parking lot that is not a teacher/staff.</p> <p>Other:</p> <p>Rose Reisman: (Marisa) Brought to our attention another option for food ordering program as the Lunch Lady (Mon & Weds). *Invite the rep to be at next meeting.</p>
