- Heat situation: noticed that the HEPA Air purifiers emit some cool air... we will see how the plexi glass cubicles affect heat in the school
 - *to be monitored effect of plexi to heat in school
 - *possibility during heat waves to explore move to virtual learning (Mr. Dempsey will inquire)
 - *Fans in class are effective also.
 - *Outdoor classrooms... need more logs or tree stumps... hoping to receive some. May use yoga mats as an option.
- Attendance of teachers has presented challenges... trying to fill any absence as soon as possible with at times dealing with multiple absences.
- Sacraments: handling registrations now. Attempting to celebrate with last year students... use the funds preserved to them, Gr. 2 and 7.

By-Law Amendments: by October 2021, all schools in the TCDSB are required to adopt a common by-laws template which will govern the activities of each school's CSPC. At the local level, CSPCs are permitted to make amendments to the following seven items only: 1- The number of times that a newly elected member can consecutively hold the office of Chair; 2- The number of times that the full Council shall meet (must be no less than four times annually, including the AGM); 3- The number of elected parents; 4- The number of community representatives; 5- The number of meetings that a member can miss; 6- Amendments and/or additions to standing committees; and, 7- Responsibilities of chairs of sub-committees, and if the chairs will be considered part of the executive. *require a committee to look over this list *By-Laws meet: TBA Next CSPC Meet: to be held on May 11th, 2021
