### **Fun Fair**

Estimate of expenses is \$9,376 Revenue expected is \$4K (incremental to previous years)

Rob stated that the Centenary funds raised will cover the costs of Fun Fair.

Questions included: How will we make \$4K more than we've made in the past? In the past we have not approved the budget for Fun Fair in advance, why do we need to do this.

The council is not comfortable approving a budget as it is presented today with an increase of 40% of either attendees or sales. The risk of committing funds for the expenses as presented is not acceptable to the council.

With much discussion about previous revenue and what a reasonable expectation would be for revenue.
